TallahasseeVoices is a pro bono internet survey panel sponsored by Kerr & Downs Research, WFSU-FM, the Tallahassee Democrat, and WCTV. Survey was conducted in August 2009. 613 of the 6,000 panel members responded. Results were weighted to reflect the demographics of the 90%+ local residents who have access to the internet at home, work, or school.

TallahasseeVoices rates President Obama

- In the **last** of a four-part survey, TallahasseeVoices panelists (citizens of Leon County) rate President Obama on helping disadvantaged persons, social security, and race relations.
- Democrats represent 58% of the panel, Republicans represent 25%, and independents represent 17%.
- More citizens believe President Obama has **not met** expectations than believe he has **exceeded** expectations on helping disadvantaged persons, social security, and race relations.
- “Ill-advised” and “premature” are the two most frequently used descriptors of President Obama’s comments on the recent altercation between Henry Louis Gates Jr., the nation's pre-eminent black scholar, and the Cambridge police.

TallahasseeVoices rates President Obama

Percentages of TallahasseeVoices panelists who believe President Obama has **met or exceeded** expectations are as follows:

- 57% - helping disadvantaged persons
- 39% - social security
- 54% - race relations

Percentages vary widely by party affiliation with independents' ratings more similar to Democrats' ratings than to Republicans' ratings.

- 2 times as many Leon County residents believe Obama has **not met** expectations on helping disadvantaged persons than believe he has **exceeded** expectations
- 31% of Leon County residents feel President Obama has **not met** expectations on helping disadvantaged persons; 14% believe he has **exceeded** expectations on helping disadvantaged persons
- Obama has **not met** expectations on helping disadvantaged persons by party affiliation
 - 18% of Democrats
 - 64% of Republicans
 - 22% of Independents

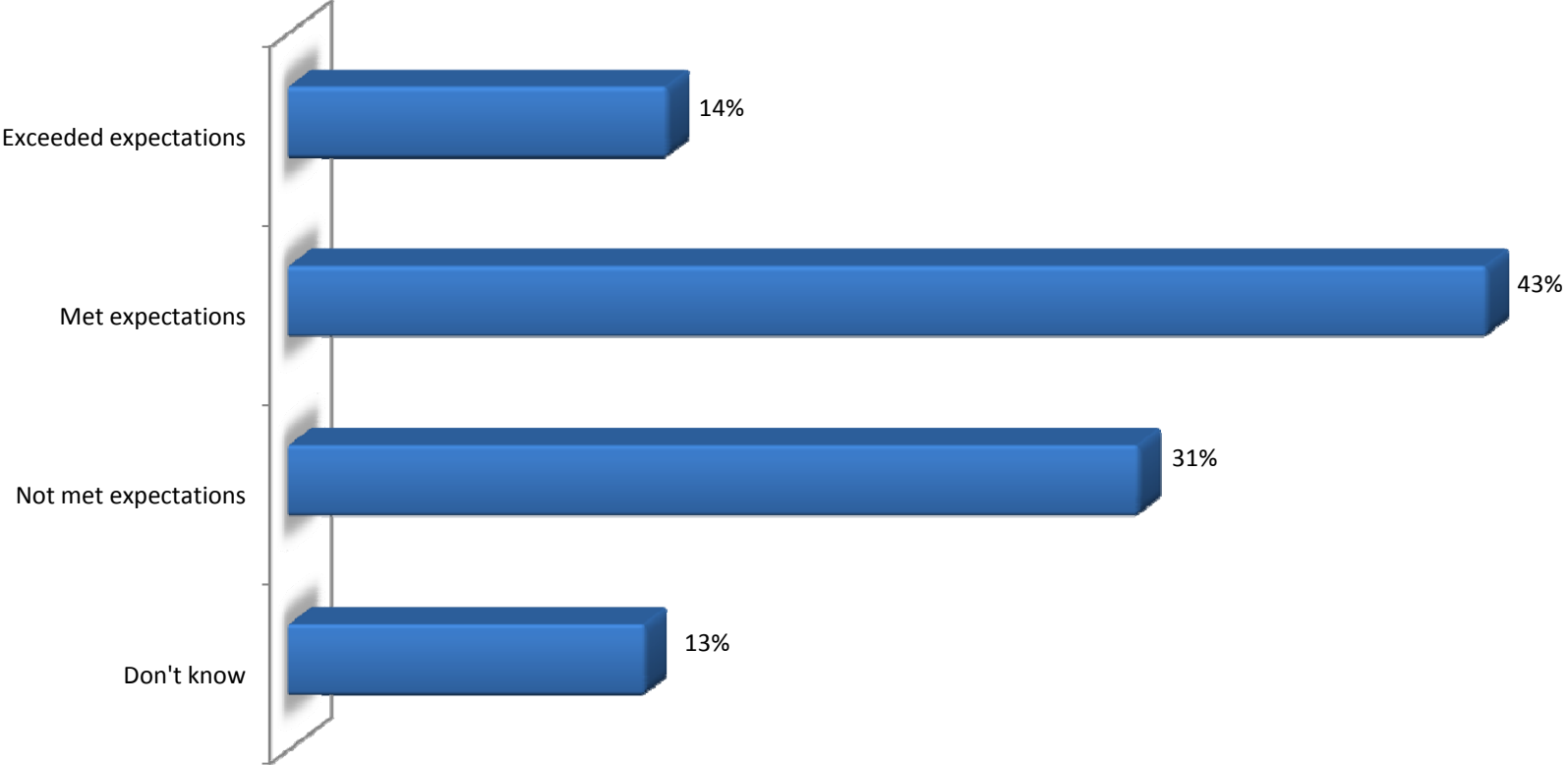
Executive summary

- 7 times as many Leon County residents believe Obama has **not met** expectations on social security than believe he has **exceeded** expectations
- 42% of Leon County residents feel President Obama has **not met** expectations on social security; 6% believe he has **exceeded** expectations on social security
- Obama has **not met** expectations on social security by party affiliation
 - 29% of Democrats
 - 77% of Republicans
 - 34% of Independents

Executive summary

- Nearly 2 times as many Leon County residents believe Obama has **not met** expectations on race relations than believe he has **exceeded** expectations
- 41% of Leon County residents feel President Obama has **not met** expectations on race relations; 23% believe he has **exceeded** expectations on race relations
- Obama has **not met** expectations on race relations by party affiliation
 - 28% of Democrats
 - 75% of Republicans
 - 35% of Independents

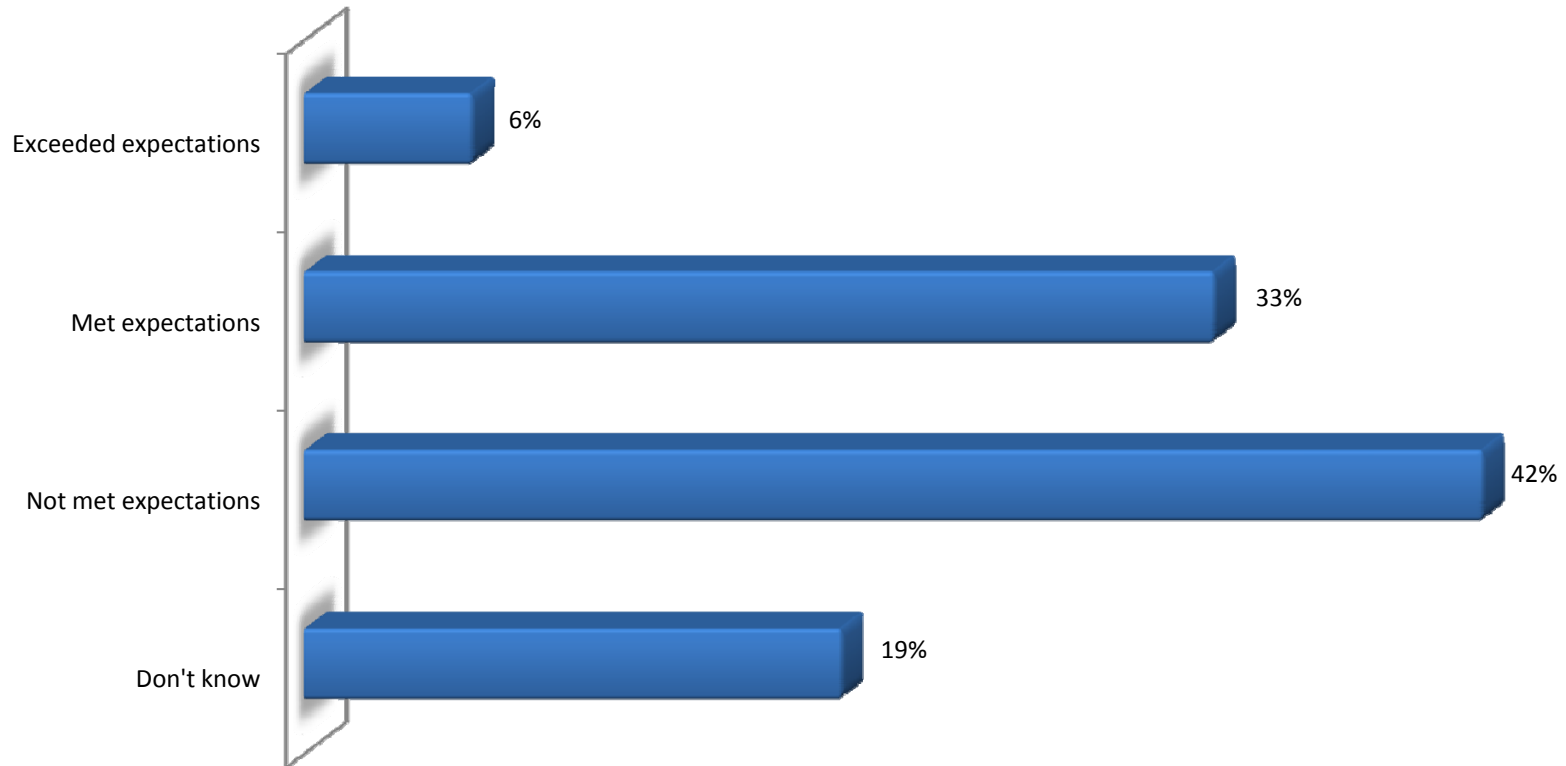
Obama's performance on helping disadvantaged

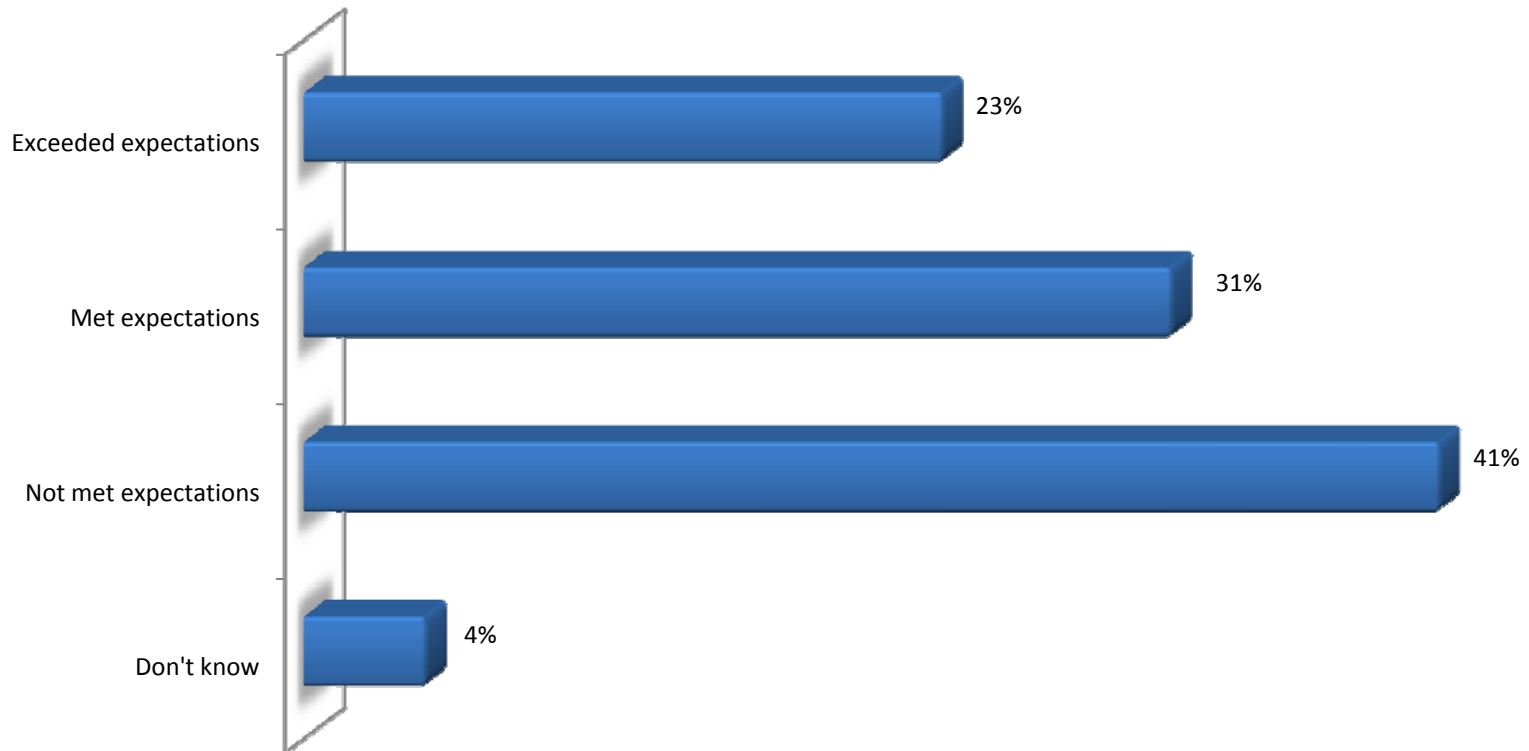
Obama's performance on dealing with social security

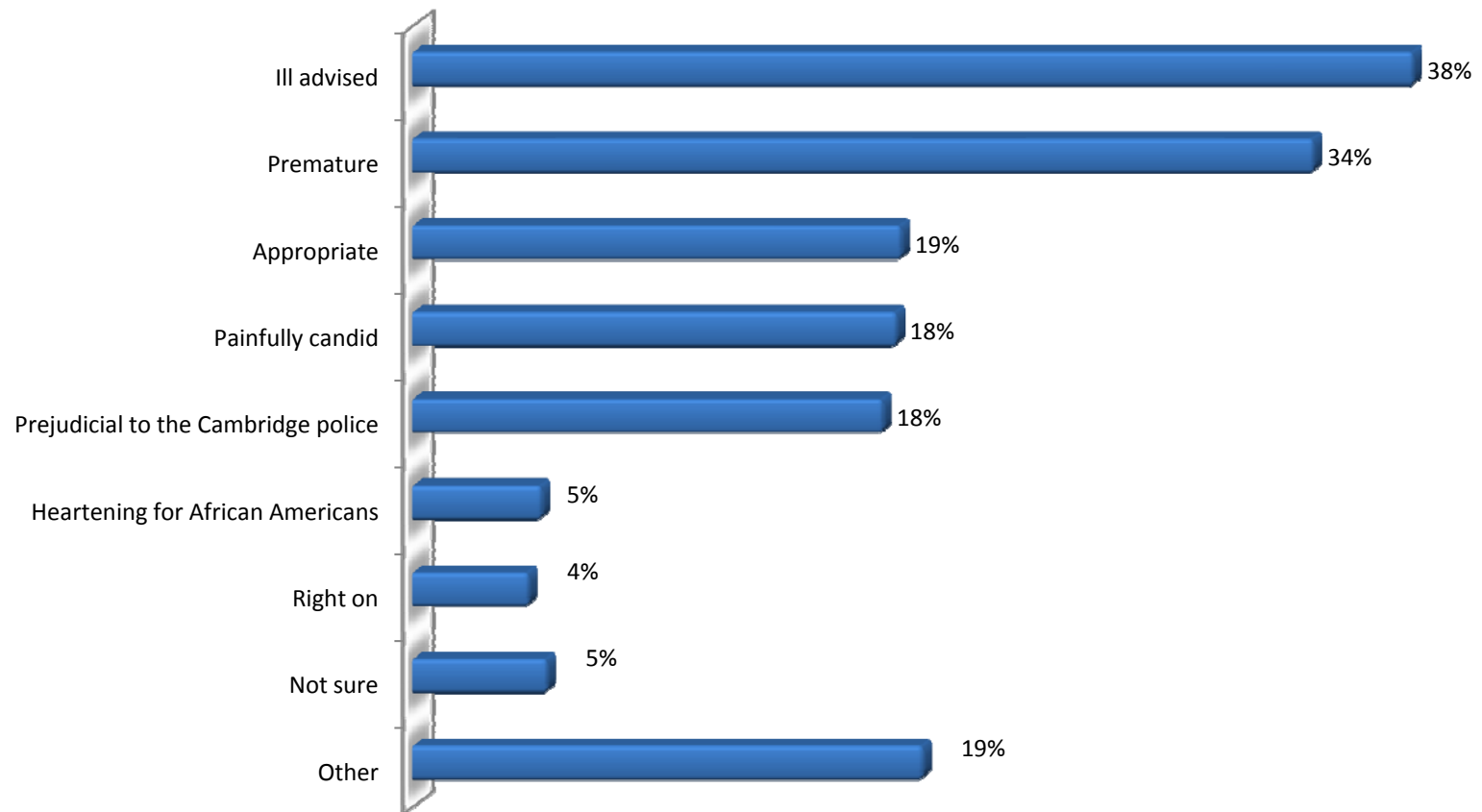
Obama's performance on race relations

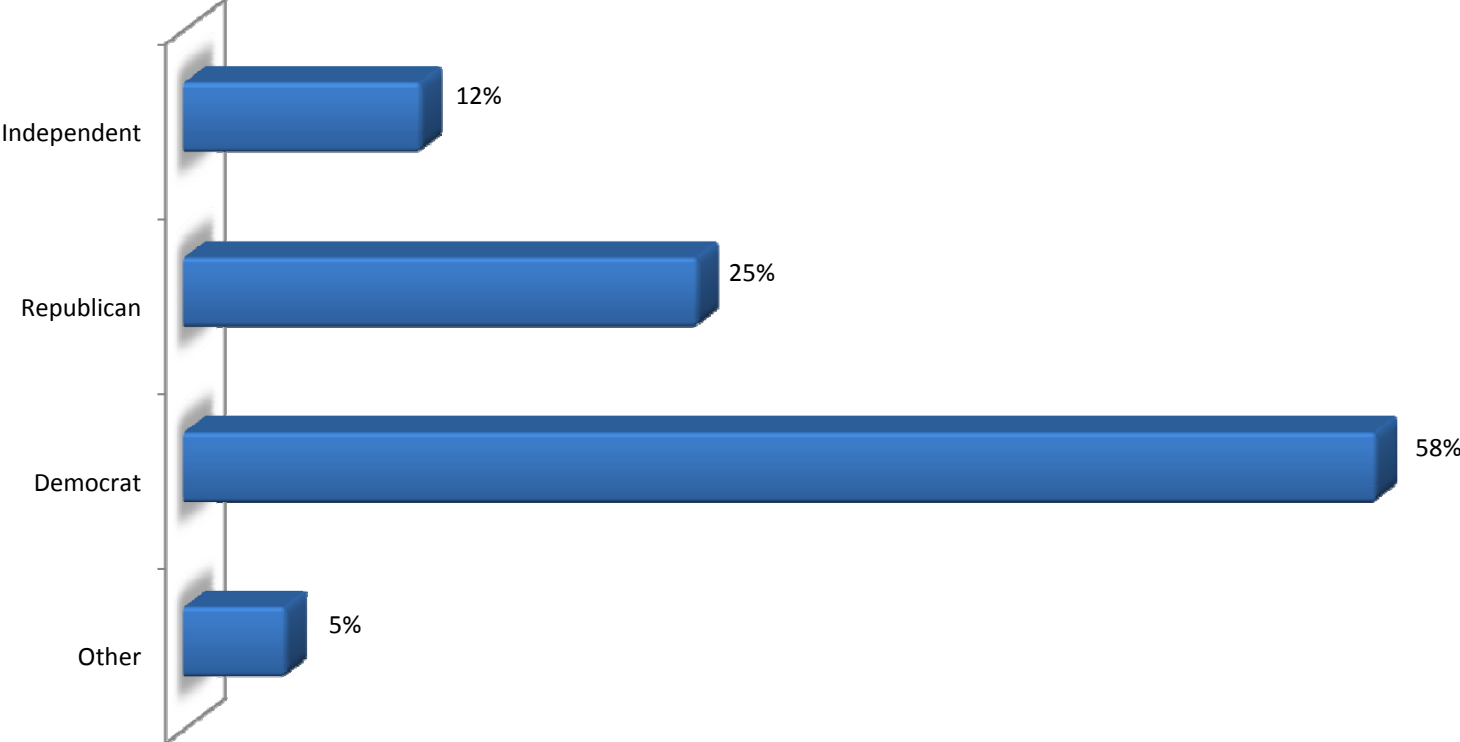
Rating of Obama's comments to Gates/Cambridge Police altercation

Party registration of TallahasseeVoices panel

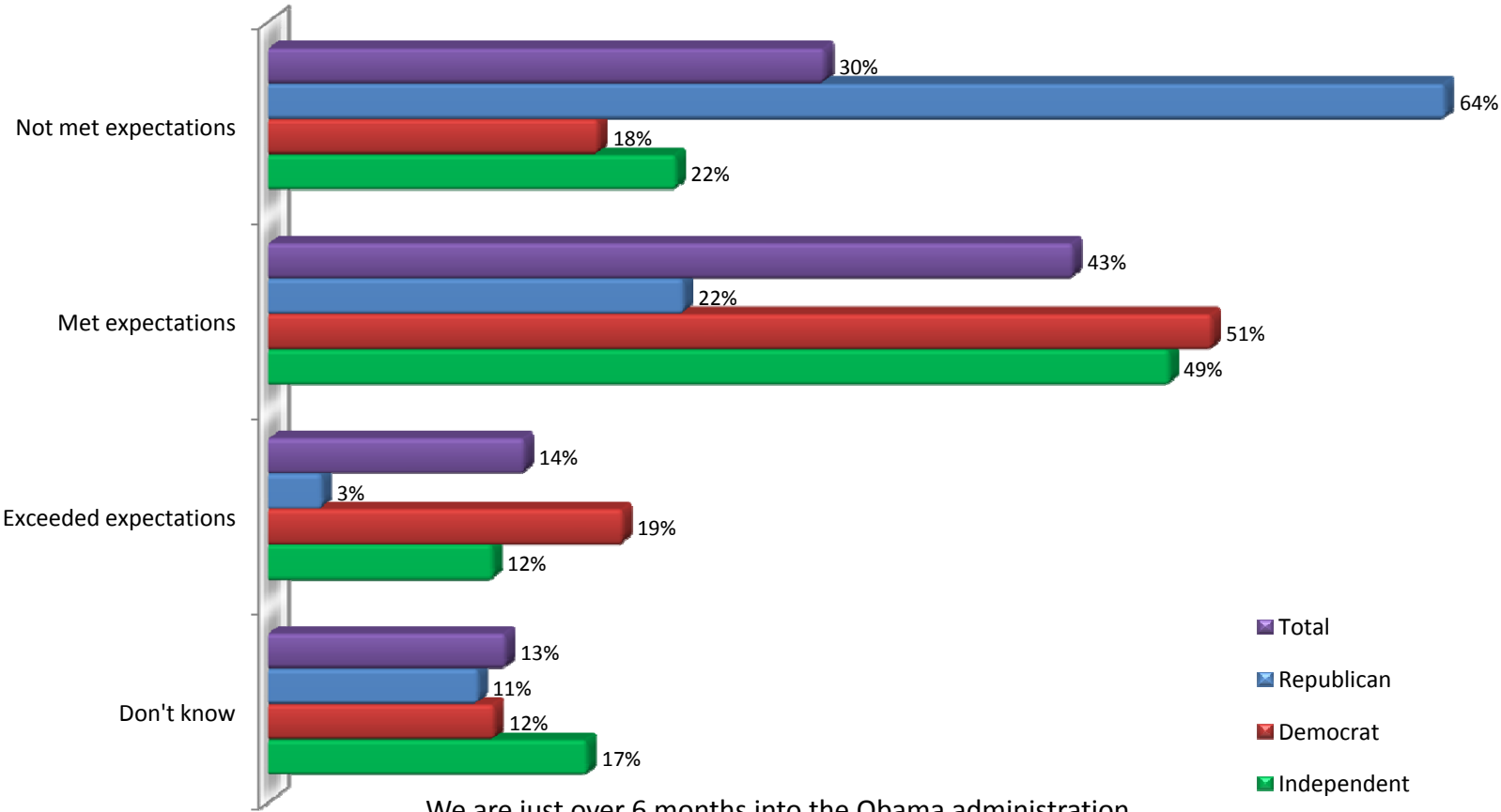


Are you registered as a Democrat, Republican, or Independent?

Answers by party affiliation

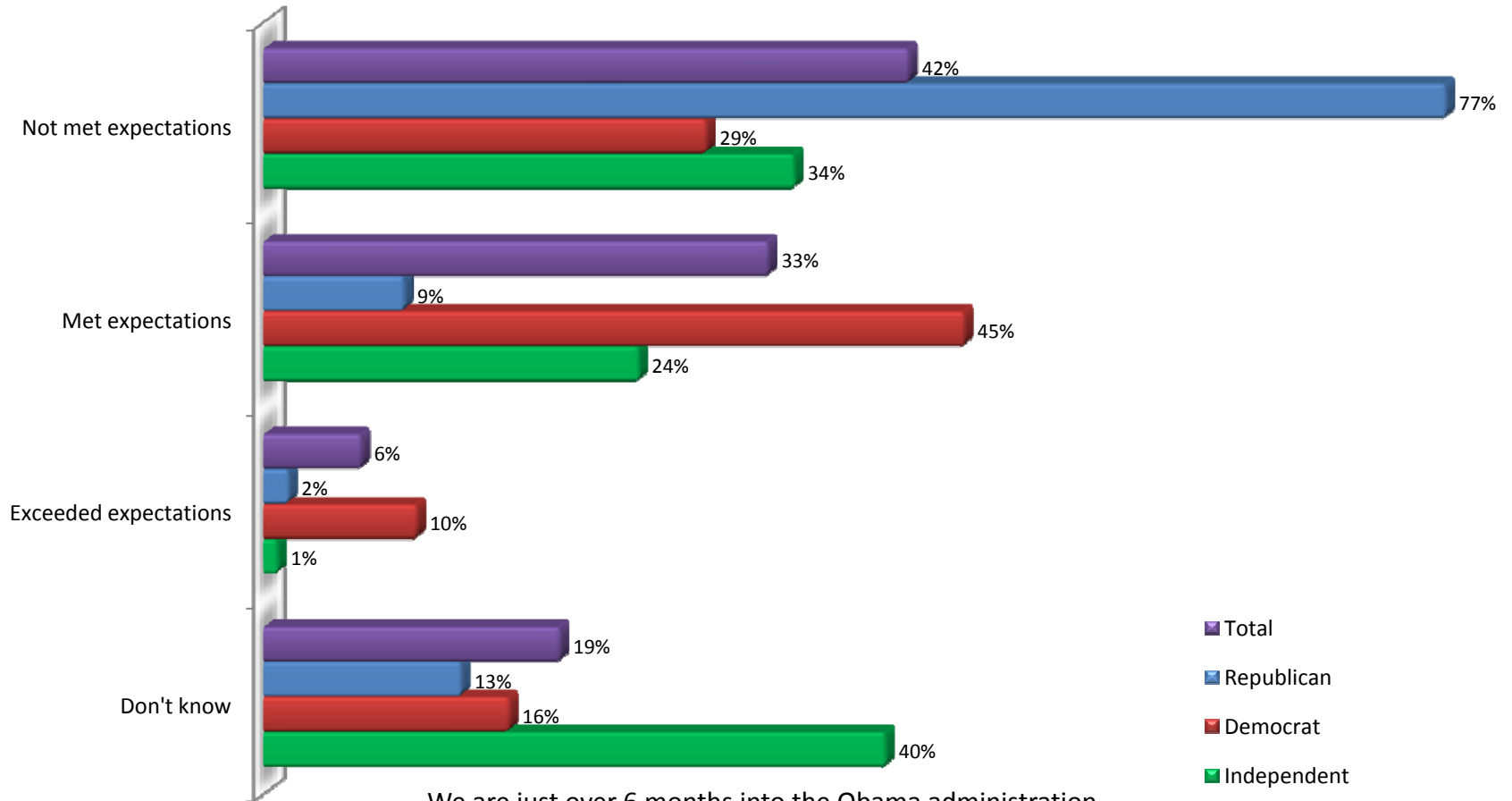

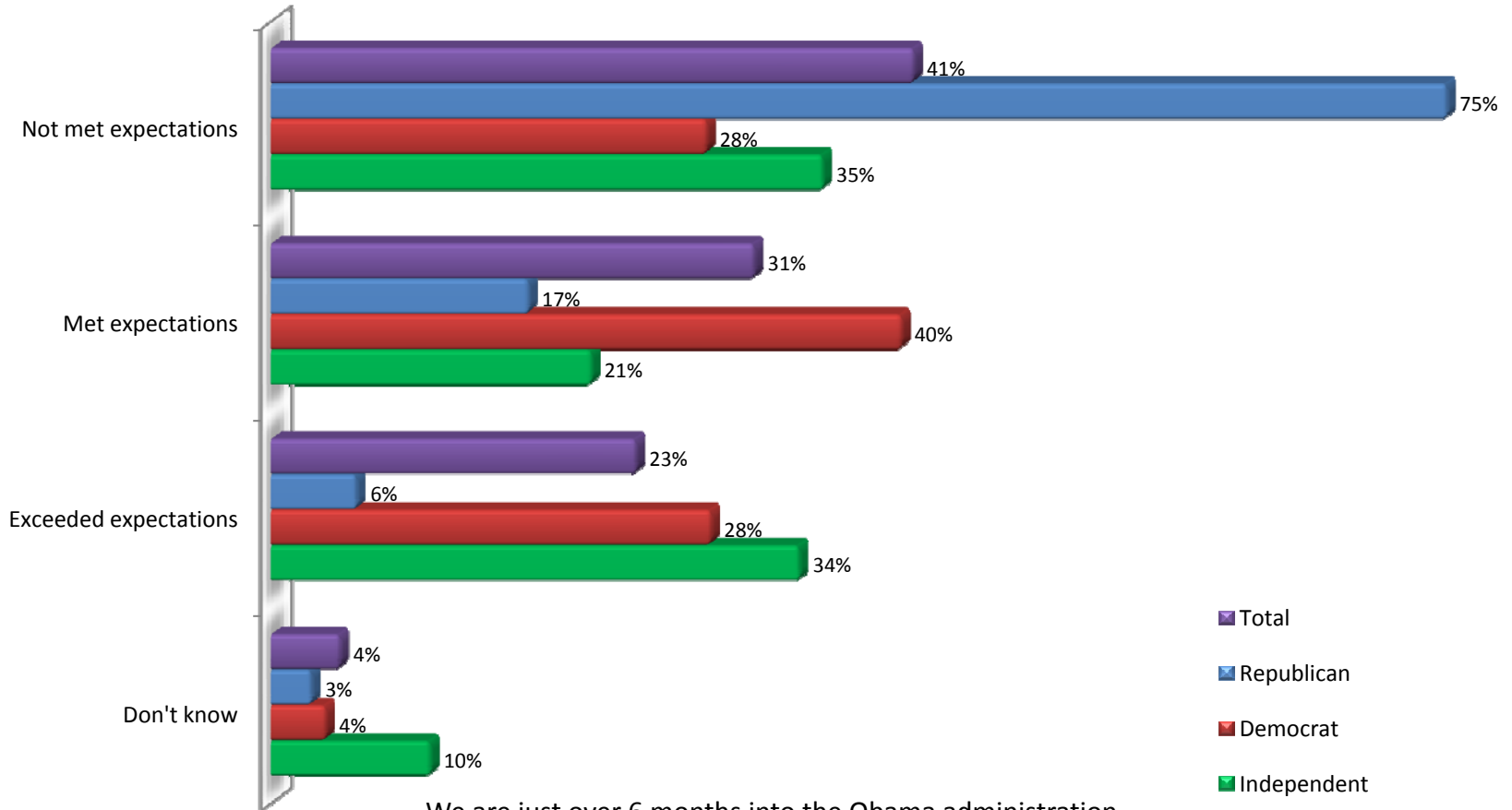
Obama's performance on dealing with social security

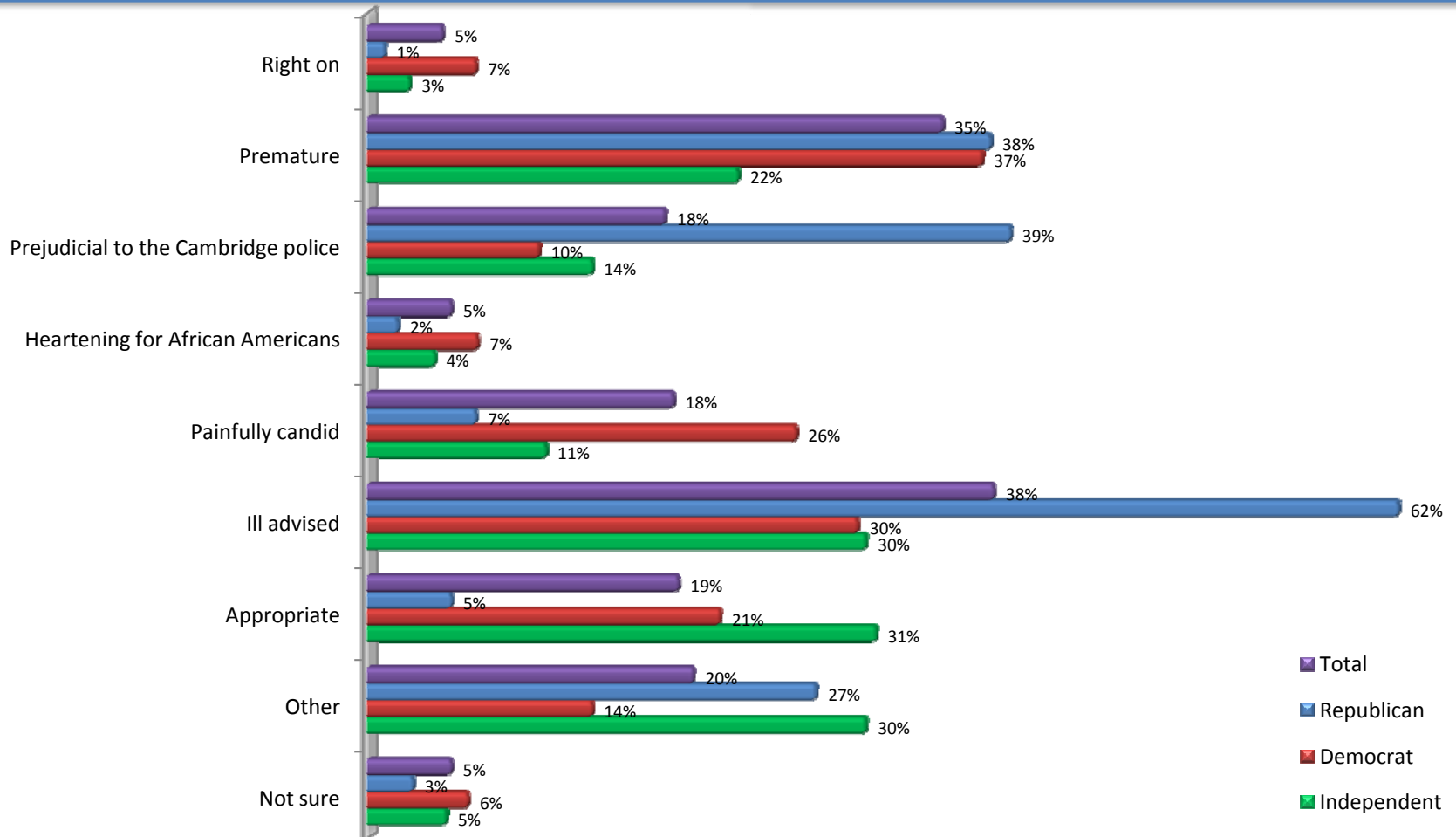
Obama's performance on race relations
