

Allocation of Tax Dollars

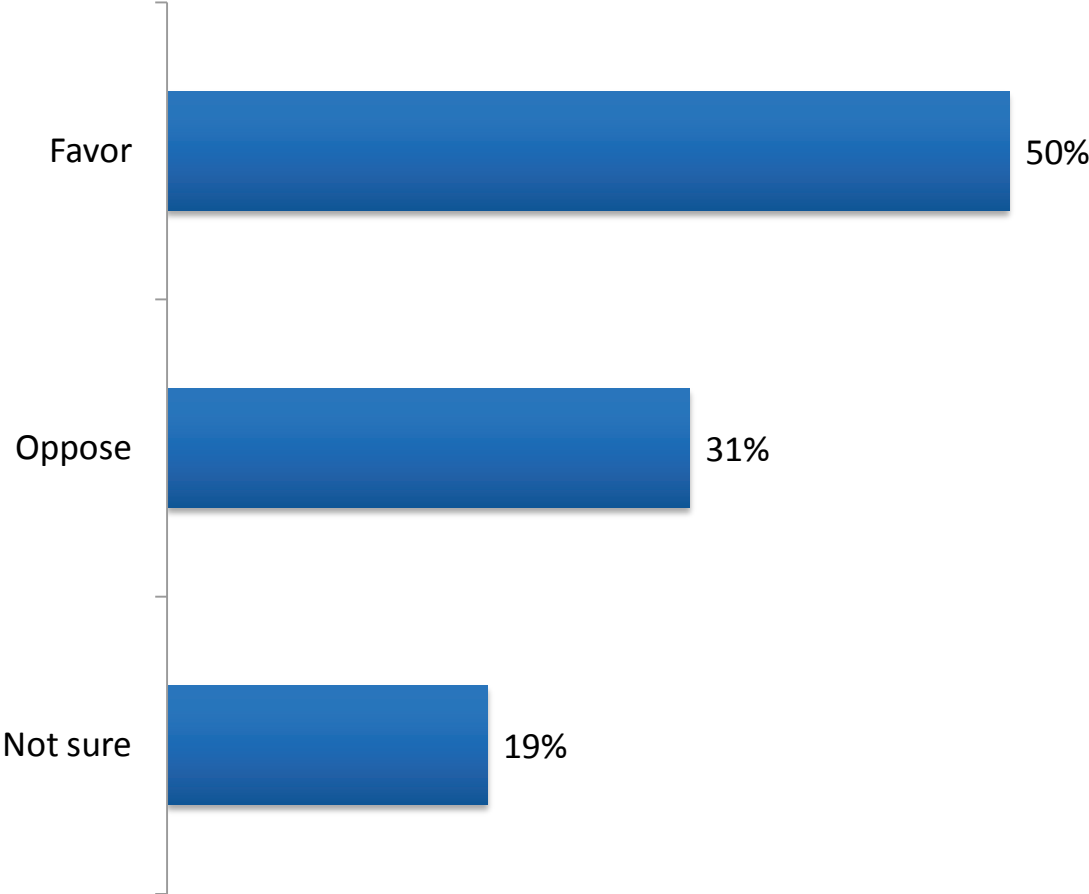

Results were weighted to reflect the demographics of the 90%+ local residents who have access to the Internet at home, work, or school.

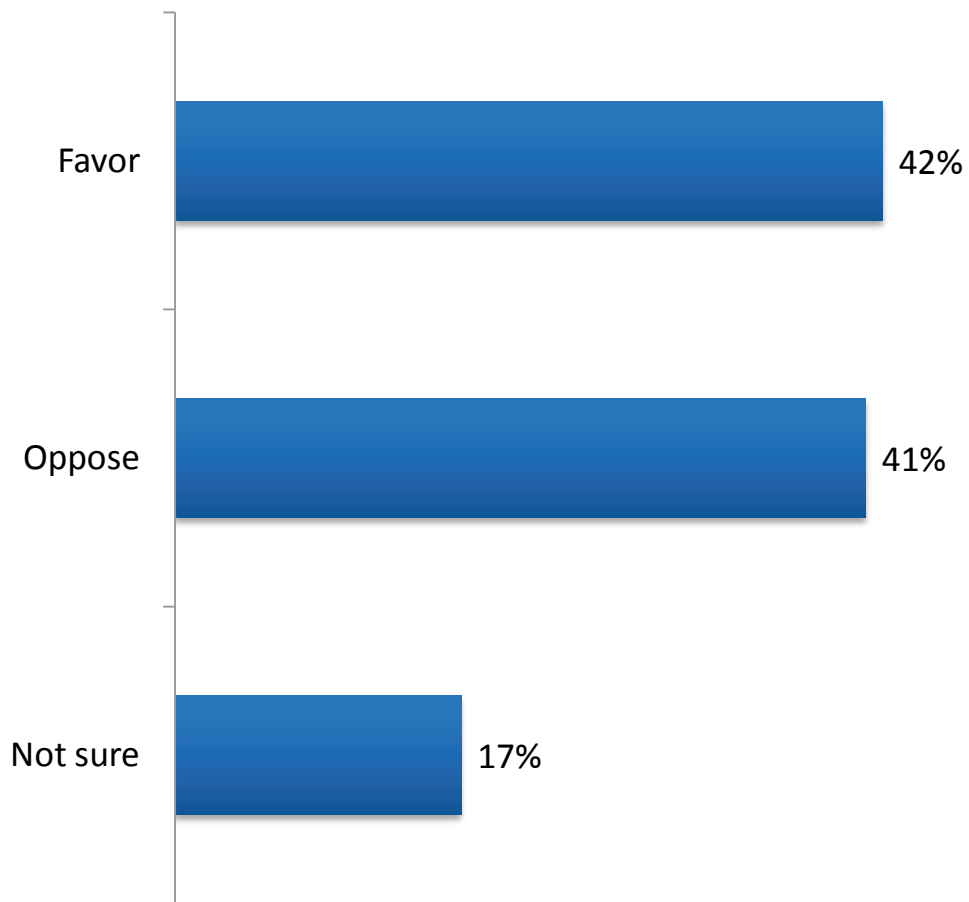
Executive Summary

- Leon County residents are willing to be generous with their tax dollars IF City & County governments list which organizations receive taxpayer money and how much each receives.
 - 70% of taxpayers approve of City & County governments spending their tax dollars to help fund charitable organizations
 - 55% of taxpayers approve of City & County governments spending their tax dollars to help fund cultural, scientific, & artistic organizations
- 97% of citizens believe City & County governments should be required to publish a list of all organizations to which they allocate taxpayers' dollars and show how much each organization received.
- 50% of citizens favor letting citizens “vote” on which organizations receive local tax dollars.
- 42% of citizens favor local government funding for the Brogan Museum of Art & Science; 41% oppose.

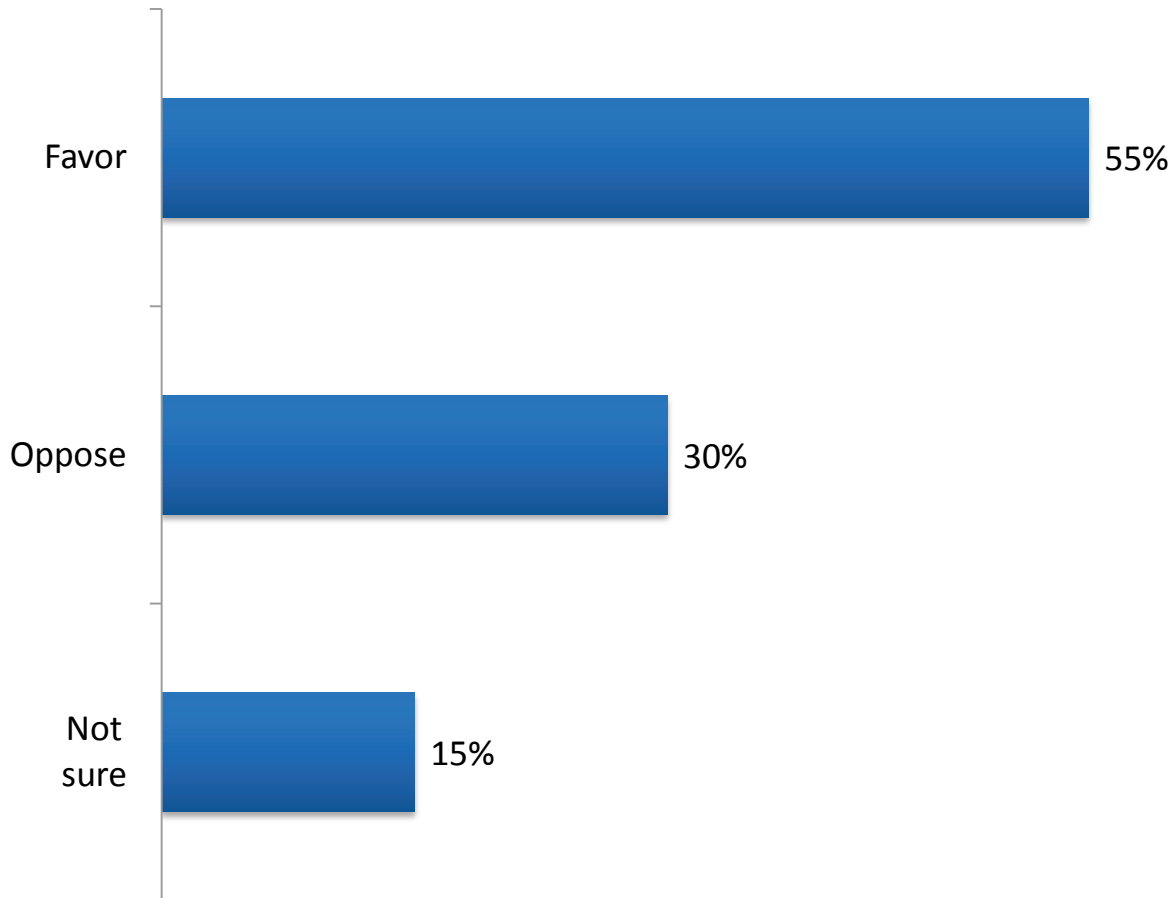
Do you favor or oppose letting citizens “vote” on which organizations and institutions receive local tax dollars?



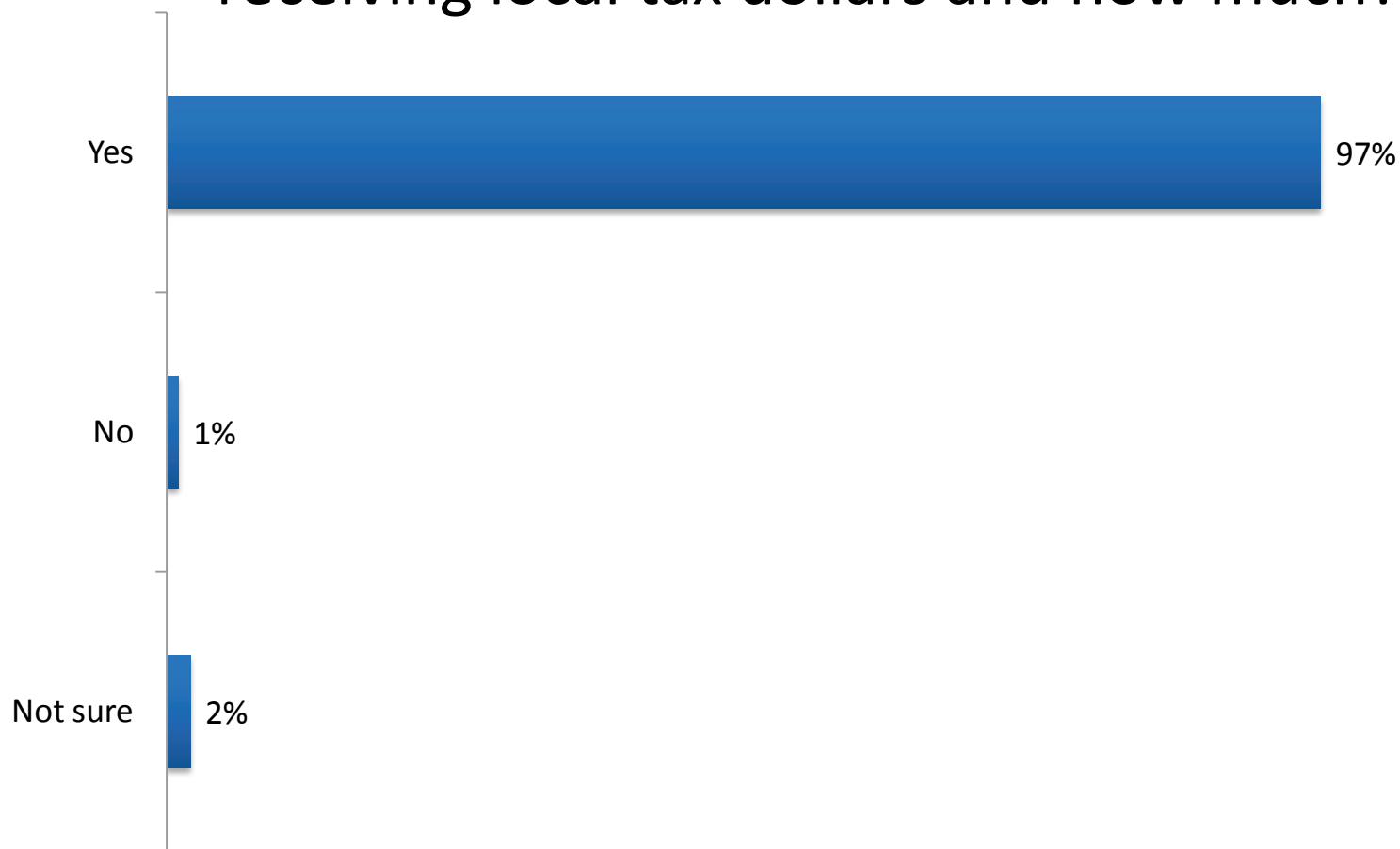
Do you favor or oppose the Leon County Commission or the City of Tallahassee spending some of your tax dollars to support the Brogan Museum of Art & Science?



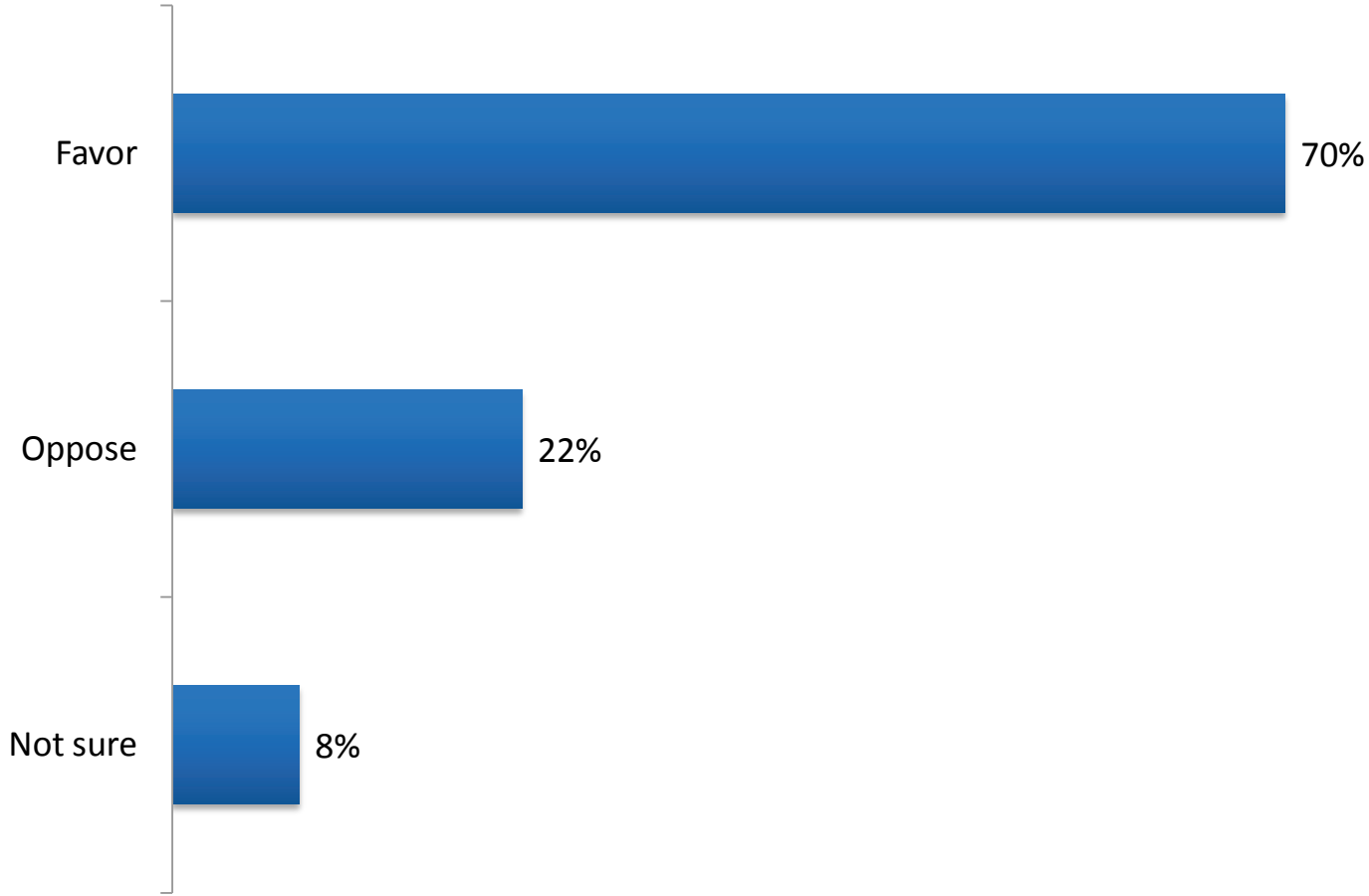
Do you favor or oppose the Leon County Commission or the City of Tallahassee spending some of your tax dollars to fund cultural, scientific, artistic, etc. organizations?
